Social Media Specialist

The social media specialist will support the Senior Organizing Manager and Political Director in creating graphics and some video content to educate the public about ranked-choice voting and FairVote Washington's events.

Responsibilities include:

- Interacting with coalition members' content
- Creating and encouraging engagement in Facebook events
- Creating graphics in Canva
- Posting graphics to Instagram, Facebook, TikTok
- Bonus: creating video content for IG, FB, TT

Preferred candidates will have knowledge, experience, or willingness to learn:

- Basic graphic design using Canva
- Basic knowledge and comfort interacting with content on Instagram, Facebook, and TikTok
- Basic knowledge and comfort creating content on Instagram and Facebook. TikTok is a bonus

Duration:

Social Media Specialist volunteers are asked to commit to volunteering 5 hours per week for 2 months.

Interns are asked to commit 5-20 hours per week for 3 months.

Requirements:

- Reliable access to a cell phone, computer, and internet access
- Interest in creating content in congruence with digital learning trends

Volunteer Recruiter:

All of FairVote Washington's events are made possible through volunteer engagement. We are seeking dedicated volunteers to support other volunteers to sign up for upcoming events and/or discover what kinds of actions the interested people are willing to take.

Responsibilities include:

- Calling 25-50 people per week (phone list and script provided)
- Signing volunteers up for events on Mobilize.com (provided)
- Reporting back with a summary of information

Duration:

- No duration required, but preference for 2 months, minimum

Requirements:

- Access to a computer, reliable internet, a phone, and email
- Enjoys engaging people in the work of bringing RCV to Washington

Tabling Specialists:

Talking to voters in public places is the cornerstone of FairVote Washington's outreach and education efforts.

Data Specialist:

Speaking with everyday Washingtonians at markets, fairs, and festivals is a cornerstone for FairVote Washington's outreach operation. We speak with several hundred people each month, and work hard to stay organized.

We are seeking (a) data specialist(s) to help us translate the written sign-ups into digital documentation on Google Sheets.

Responsibilities include:

- Digitizing paper documents using a scanning app, scanner, or photograph
- Transcribing the hand-written volunteer signup information onto a Google Sheet
- Bonus: If comfortable using EveryAction/VoteBuilder, data upload into our CRM is a possibility

Duration:

- No duration is required, but preferably 3 month commitment of 1-3 hours per week

Requirements:

- Reliable access to a computer and internet
- Interest in operational support
